



- Avoid most fancy fabrics. They are very expensive and they tend to be difficult to work with; they tend to be slippery and fray.
- The only fabric from The fancy fabrics I would consider for a beginner is satin if you REALLY want it for a project like a kimono.
- Start your shopping around the checkout. There is usually a bin or 2 with bolt ends (pre cut pieces that are left over from a bolt of fabric) or small pieces about 1/2 1 meter for only \$1/piece.
- Next check out the Discount Table and Bargain Fabrics at the back (\$2-\$6/m). There are lots of cottons, cotton blends and some heavier fabrics here. Avoid sheer (see through) or slipery fabrics. Give the fabric a tug to see if it's stretchy or not, avoid stretchy fabric unless the list says it is o.k. for the project.
- Then check out the cotton and cotton blend fabrics & then the new/seasonal and heavier fabics.

<u>Note:</u> There are tags at the end of the bolts of fabric that say how much the fabric costs per meter and what width the fabric is. Pay attention to the fabric width when you are getting fabric for larger projects!

## Measuring for Curtains & Determining the Amount of Fabric Needed



- 1- Measure the width of the window in inches W, window width.
- 2- Measure the length you would like the curtain to be in inches L. Make sure it is at least the length of the height of the window!
- 3- Decide how many panels you want most windows use 2 panels. Divide the Width by the number of panels **P** , panel width .

### P=W/# of panels

4- Decide how full you want the curtains to be (flat - 1X width, some fullness - 1.5X width, very full (ruffled) - 2X width) - **F, fullness width**.

### F = P X fullness (1, 1.5 or 2)

5- Add 2" to the total from 4- for seam allowance - TOTAL Panel width.

#### **TOTAL Panel Width = F + 2"**

6- We are doing basic curtains - nothing fancy, they just have a casing ans fit on the rod. Add **6**" to the length for the casing and hem.

### Curtain Length (inches) = L + 6"

7- Convert your Curtain Length from inches to m.

Curtain Length (cm) = Curtain Length(inches) X 2.54 cm/inch

Curtain Length (m) = Curtain Length (cm)/100

- 8- Select Fabric and determine the fabric width (read package or the label at the end of a fabric bolt) FW.
- 9- Determine how much fabric to buy.

#### Total Curtain Width = TOTAL Panel Width X # panels
